Parental Support & Code of Conduct

VYO Education Center (VYOEC) is here to introduce ethics/morality, Hindu and Pushtimargiya values, and culture to students.

VYOEC is blessed to have many families and students that are interested in maintaining and promoting our cultural heritage. VYOEC wholeheartedly embraces and values the Hindu and Pushti Marg heritage and is building environment to promote them.

Basic and vital to the universal needs of the child is an involved parents who demonstrates to their child that VYOEC is important by being engaged in their child's VYOEC activities and events that occur during the school year. With this said, our goal is to encourage parents to participate at VYOEC during the duration of their child's enrollment at VYOEC. It is up to the parents to follow through with this learning at home and encourage children to apply these lessons in their daily lives.

1. Parent/s of children attending the VYOEC are required to be present in the premises, attend Satsang in the Main Hall, teach or volunteer, while the children are doing Prayer and attending the School.
2. It is recommended that at least one parent be a volunteer in the School.
3. Children should be punctual to School. The Prayers will begin promptly at scheduled time. Late arriving students are asked to wait outside until prayers are finished.
4. Children are highly encouraged to wear Indian clothes to the School. Salwar Kameez for girls and Kurta Pajama for boys are recommended.
5. Please make sure that the children come to school equipped with paper, pens / pencils, crayons etc. along with their books.
6. 80%-85% attendance is required for certificate at end of the school year.
7. Please mark your calendars for special dates. Parents are required to attend all Parents-Teachers meetings.
8. If you know in advance about your child not being able to attend School on any Sunday, please inform the teacher and ask about the class missed. It is the responsibility of the child and parent to inquire what lesson was taught in the class and catch up.
9. Please insist that your children take home all their belongings. VYOEC is not responsible for any lost items.
10. Please make use of e-mail, suggestion box or talk to teachers or committee to let us know your ideas and suggestions.
11. VYOEC adhere Pushtimarg values. Please dress properly when you come here or bring your children.
12. This is YOUR school. Please talk to your child about discipline, keeping it quiet, clean and beautiful. Be a role model for your child and teach them by example.
13. Please make sure that your child turns his/her cell phone off before he/she enters the classroom. Cell phones ringing during class are a great distraction and therefore inexcusable.

In doing so we will conduct ourselves in a mutually respectful manner in order to help maintain the harmonious atmosphere that is present at VYOEC.
